## WILDFLOWER UPDATE

Although we're told they'll get even better, the hills that border Wildflower Meadows are absolutely beautiful. In fact we've heard that some areas are as brilliant as a "Thomas Kincaid" painting. Our featured Wildflower for this issue is the LUPINUS PERENNIS. It's more common name is...WILD LUPINE, a perennial plant in the pea family with beautiful pink to blue flowers found primarily on dry sandy soils in open full sun habitats. It is the only food for the Karner Blue Butterfly's Caterpillar. About mid-April wild lupines sprout and form clumps of flowering stalks. Peak bloom is reached in mid-May.
